## "AFIRMATIVE"

- -There is
  - There is a fridge in his house

#### -There are

 There are some fridges in coppel

#### "NEGATIVE"

- -There isn't (there's no)
  - There isn't an apple or the table.
- -There aren't (There are no)
  - There aren't any apples on the tables.

#### "INTERROGATIVE"

- -Is there...?
  - Is there a cinema in pichucalco?
