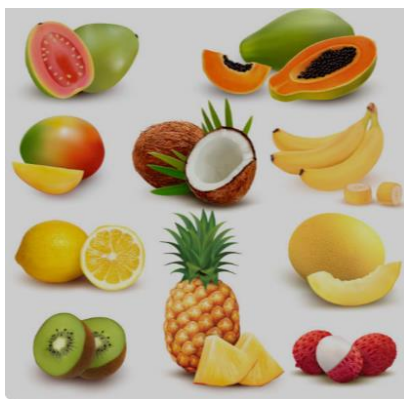

# ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY



ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY		
	ADVERBS	EXAMPLES
100%	Always	• Jenna <u>always</u> talks too loud.
90%	Usually	• She <u>usually</u> sings in the shower.
80%	Normally	• She doesn't <u>normally</u> arrive until ten.
70%	Often	• I <u>often</u> feel a pain in my stomach.
50%	Sometimes	• My eyes <u>sometimes</u> get red and itchy in the summer.
30%	Occasionally	• She watches the kids for us <u>occasionally</u> .
15%	Seldom	• I <u>seldom</u> go home after 5 o'clock in the afternoon.
5%	Rarely	• The police <u>rarely</u> shoot to kill.
0%	Never	• I <u>never</u> get to bed before 11.
