90%	Usually	She <u>usually</u> sings in the shower.	
80%	Normally	She doesn't <u>normally</u> arrive until ten.	
70%	Often	• I <u>often</u> feel a pain in my stomach.	
50%	Sometimes	My eyes <u>sometimes</u> get red and itch in the summer.	
30%	Occasionally	She watches the kids for us occasionally.	
15%	Seldom	1 <u>seldom</u> go home after 5 o'clock in the afternoon.	
5%	Rarely	The police <u>rarely</u> shoot to kill.	
0%	Never	• I <u>never</u> get to bed before 11.
