

- A TABLE WITH QUESTIONS IN ENGLISH USING INTERROGATIVE WORDS (WH QUESTIONS) SUCH AS "WHAT," "WHERE," "WHEN," "WHO," "WHY," "WHICH," AND "HOW."
- THE SPANISH TRANSLATION OF EACH QUESTION WORD IS SHOWN.
- THIS TOPIC IS VERY USEFUL FOR LEARNING HOW TO FORMULATE QUESTIONS IN ENGLISH USING THE CORRECT QUESTION WORDS.



USE OF "THERE IS/THERE ARE" AND ITS NEGATIVE AND INTERROGATIVE FORMS:

- THE USE OF "THERE IS" AND "THERE ARE" TO TALK ABOUT THE EXISTENCE OF SOMETHING IS EXPLAINED.
- EXAMPLES OF AFFIRMATIVE, NEGATIVE, AND INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES WITH "THERE IS/THERE ARE" ARE INCLUDED.
- THE USE OF THE NEGATIVE FORMS "THERE ISN'T/THERE AREN'T" AND THE INTERROGATIVE FORMS "IS THERE...?/ARE THERE...?" ARE SHOWN.

THIRD-PERSON VERB CONJUGATION:

- A LIST OF INFINITIVE VERBS IS PRESENTED FOR THE STUDENT TO CONJUGATE IN THE THIRD-PERSON SINGULAR.
- THE RULE OF ADDING "-S" TO THE END OF THE VERB IN MOST CASES IS REINFORCED.

- THE STRUCTURE OF QUESTIONS IS SHOWN, INCLUDING SUBJECT, VERB, AND OBJECT.
