- There aren't any Apple on the table.



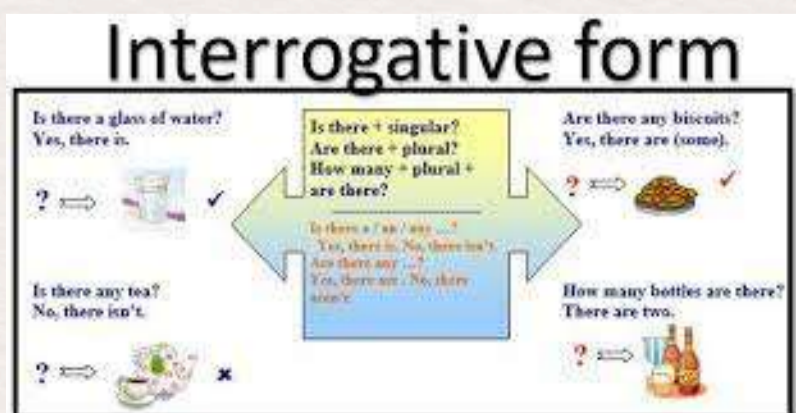
