**AFFIRMATIVE**    Subject + Verbtobe + Adverb of frequency + Camplement

Susan is always happy.

**NEGATIVE**    Subject + Verbtobe + Not + Adverb of frequency + Camplement

Nick is not usually in México.

**INTERROGATIVE**    Verbtobe + Subject + Adverb of frequency + Camplement

Is peter usually sick?

**AFFIRMATIVE**    Subject + Adverb of frequency + Ver + Camplement

**NEGATIVE**    Subject + Don't / doesn't + Adverb of frequency + Ver + Camplement

**INTERROGATIVE**    Do / does + Subject + Adverb of frequency + Ver + Camplement
