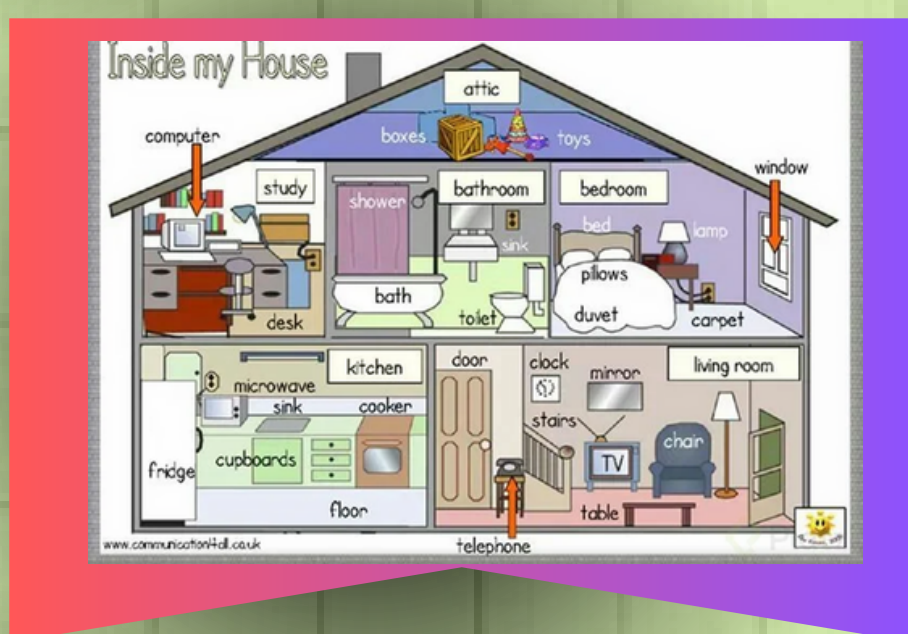

## Example

### Affirmative form

- There is a red clock in the bedroom.
- There are a two books onthe bed.

### Negative form

- There isn't a blue clock in the bedroom.
- There aren't three books on the bed.

### Interrogative form

- Is there a clock in the bedroom?
- Are there any books on the bed?

### Answer

- + Yes, there is. or Yes, there are.
- - No, there isn't. or No, there aren't.

**Who**

- Ask about person
- Act as subject of the sentence
- Who is that woman?
- Who are you phoning?

**Where**

- Asking in or at what place or position
- Where do you live?
- Where are my boots?

**When**

- Asking about time, occasion, moment
- When can I see you?
- When did you last see him?

**Why**

- Asking for reason, explanation
- Why were you late?
- Why was he late?

**What**

- Asking for specific thing, object
- What's the matter?
- What time is it?

**How**

- Asking for way, manner, form
- How does it work?
- How do you go to school?

**Which**

- Asking about choice
- Which is better exercise? – swimming or tennis
- Which of the applicants has got the job?

**How many**

- Asking about quantity
- Used with countable nouns
- How many people were there?

**How often**

- Asking about frequency
- How often do you go swimming?

- When? ¿Cuándo?
- Why? / ¿Por qué?
- What? / ¿Qué? ¿Cuál?
- How? / ¿Cómo?
- Which? / ¿Cuál?
- How many? / ¿Cuántos?

Use What to ask about things.

- What do you do?

Use Where to ask about place.

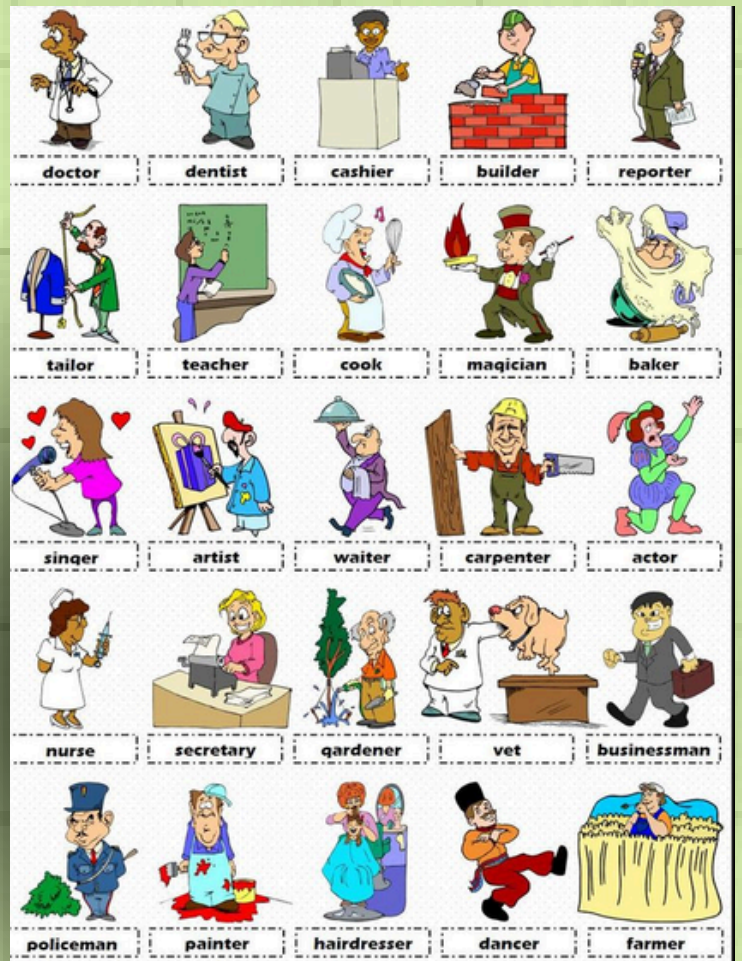
- Where do you work?
