CAN FOR ABILITY.



POSITIVE

El verbo modal "can" se utiliza en inglés para expresar la habilidad o capacidad de una persona para realizar una acción en el presente o futuro

EXAMPLE

- I can swim. (Puedo nadar.)
- She can play the piano. (Ella sabe tocar el piano.)



NEGATIVE

En su forma negativa, "can" se convierte en "can't" o "cannot", indicando la falta de habilidad o capacidad



EXAMPLE

- He can't drive. (Él no sabe conducir.)
- They cannot speak French. (Ellos no saben hablar francés.)
