FOOD

FOOD IS A VERY IMPORTANT PART OF OUR LIVES. WE NEED IT TO SURVIVE. THERE ARE MANY DIFFERENT TYPES OF FOOD, AND WE CAN EAT IT IN MANY DIFFERENT WAYS. COUNTABLE AND UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

COUNTABLE NOUNS ARE THINGS THAT WE CAN COUNT. FOR EXAMPLE, WE CAN COUNT APPLES, ORANGES, AND CHAIRS. UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS ARE THINGS THAT WE CANNOT COUNT. FOR EXAMPLE, WE CANNOT COUNT WATER, AIR, OR HAPPINESS.










CAN FOR ABILITY


CAN" IS A MODAL VERB THAT WE USE TO TALK ABOUT ABILITY. FOR EXAMPLE, "I CAN SPEAK ENGLISH." THIS MEANS THAT I HAVE THE ABILITY TO SPEAK ENGLISH. WE CAN ALSO USE "CAN" TO ASK FOR

PERMISSION. FOR EXAMPLE, "CAN I GO TO THE BATHROOM?" THIS MEANS THAT I AM ASKING FOR PERMISSION TO GO TO THE BATHROOM.











SOME / ANY

WE USE "SOME" WITH COUNTABLE NOUNS WHEN WE ARE TALKING ABOUT A FEW OF THEM. FOR EXAMPLE, "I HAVE SOME APPLES." WE USE "ANY" WITH COUNTABLE NOUNS WHEN WE ARE TALKING ABOUT NONE OF THEM. FOR EXAMPLE. "I DON'T HAVE ANY APPLES."





ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY TELL US HOW OFTEN SOMETHING HAPPENS. SOME COMMON ADVERBS **OF FREQUENCY INCLUDE:**

ALWAYS: THIS MEANS SOMETHING HAPPENS ALL THE TIME. FOR EXAMPLE, "I ALWAYS EAT BREAKFAST."

 USUALLY: THIS MEANS SOMETHING HAPPENS MOST OF THE TIME. FOR EXAMPLE, "I USUALLY GO TO BED EARLY."

• OFTEN: THIS MEANS SOMETHING HAPPENS MANY TIMES. FOR EXAMPLE, "I OFTEN GO TO THE MOVIES."

SOMETIMES: THIS MEANS SOMETHING HAPPENS OCCASIONALLY. FOR EXAMPLE, "I SOMETIMES EAT PIZZA."

SELDOM: THIS MEANS SOMETHING HAPPENS RARELY. FOR EXAMPLE, "I SELDOM EAT FAST FOOD."

NEVER: THIS MEANS SOMETHING NEVER HAPPENS. FOR EXAMPLE, "I NEVER EAT SPICY FOOD."
