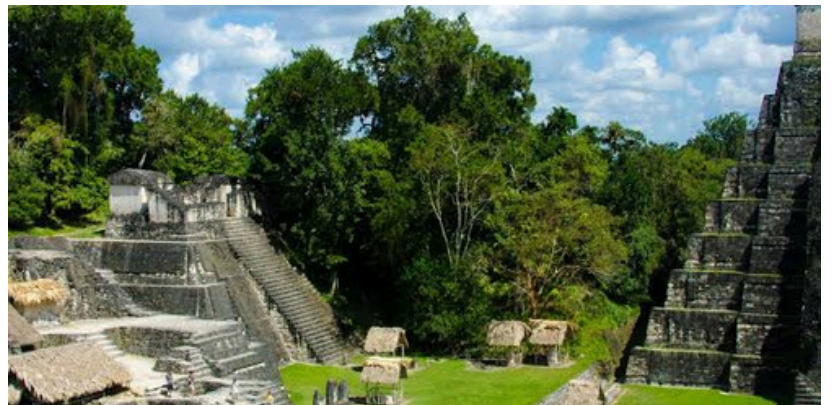


Important Places in Peten
