Go straight for two blocks, then turn right. The metro station is at the end of the street.

Which bus passes through this stop?
Bus number 34 passes by here. It goes towards the city center.
Where is the main square?
Keep walking until you reach the traffic light, then turn left. The square will be right in front of you.
How do I get to the bridge?
Go straight until the intersection, then turn right. The bridge is about a 5-minute walk.
Where is the tram?
The tram stop is just one block away. Turn right at the first street, and you'll see the tram stop.
How do I get to the Art Museum?
Walk two blocks north, then turn left. The museum will be on your right after 100 meters.
