NATO, and the European Union, and is known for its diplomatic influence globally.



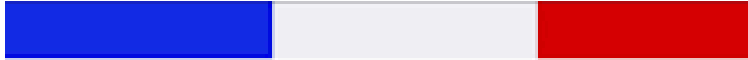
In France, there are various modes of transportation that you can use to get around

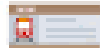
