Future be going to

Affirmative form



Subject + to be + going to + verb + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. She is going to visit her grandmother this weekend.
2. I am going to start a new job next month.
3. They are going to watch a movie tonight.

Negative form



Subject + to be (not) + going to + verb + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. He is not going to come to the party.
2. We are not going to buy that car.
3. I am not going to eat junk food anymore.

Interrogative form



To be + subject + going to + verb + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. Are Kevin going to travel this summer?
2. Is Vanesa going to take the exam tomorrow?
3. Am I going to meet your parents?
