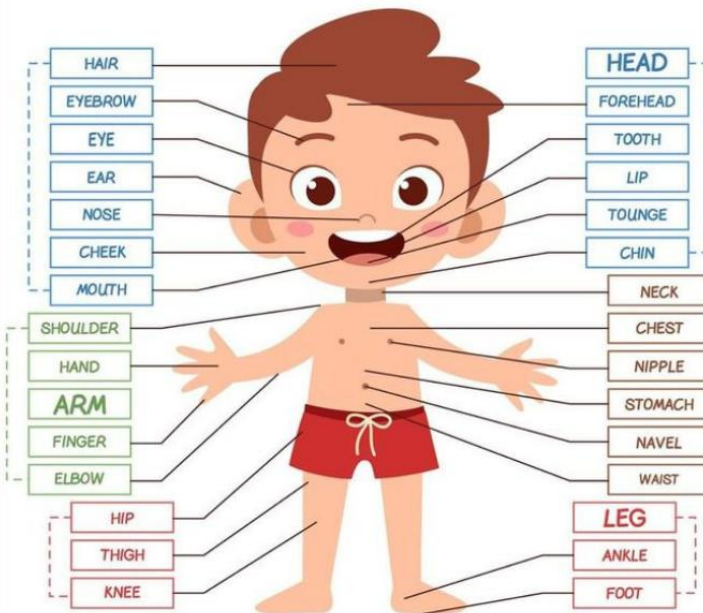

PAST SIMPLE

REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS  
IN PAST SIMPLE

- For **regular verbs**, the past is formed by adding **-ed** to the end of the verb. (**work** → **worked**).
- **Irregular verbs** have their own past forms, which don't follow a specific rule. (**go** → **went**).

AFFIRMATIVE FORM

Structure

Subject + Verb in past + Complement

Examples

1. I **visited** the museum last weekend.
2. She **cooked** a delicious meal yesterday.

NEGATIVE FORM

Structure

Subject + Negation + Verb in past + Complement

Examples

1. I **didn't** go to the party on Friday.
2. They **didn't** watch the movie last night.

INTERROGATIVE FORM

Structure

Question + Subject + Verb in past + Complement

Examples

1. **Did** you finish your homework on time?
2. **Did** he play football with his friends?
