





### ORDINAL NUMBERS



We normally add a TH to the end of a cardinal number to make it an ordinal number. Be careful of the spelling exceptions below:



1st	first	11 <sup>th</sup>	eleventh
2 <sup>nd</sup>	second	12 <sup>th</sup>	twelfth
3 <sup>rd</sup>	third	13 <sup>th</sup>	thirteenth
4 <sup>th</sup>	fourth	14 <sup>th</sup>	fourteenth
5 <sup>th</sup>	fifth	15 <sup>th</sup>	fifteenth
6 <sup>th</sup>	sixth	16th	sixteenth
$7^{th}$	seventh	17th	seventeentl

DATES: Her birthday is on the 29th.

10th tenth

CENTURIES: Shakespeare was born in the 16th century. SEQUENCE/ORDER: My team came second in the league


Complement

Subject	To be	Going to	Verb	Complement
I	am	going to	take	a taxi.
You	are	going to	go	to México City tomorrow.
Не	is	going to	study	a master next year.

### Examples

- 1. She is going to visit her grandmother tomorrow.
- 2. We are going to study for the exam this weekend.
- 3.1 am going to buy a new laptop next month.
