Affirmative form

Subject + To be + Going to + Verb

+ Complement



Examples

1. She is going to study English tomorrow.
2. We are going to visit our grandparents next weekend.
3. I am going to cook pasta for dinner.



Negative form

Subject + To be(not) + Going to + Verb + Complement

Examples

1. He is not going to play soccer today.
2. They are not going to watch a movie tonight.
3. I am not going to buy a new phone this year.
