


Past simple

• Regular and irregular verbs in past simple

• If the verb ends in -y preceded by a consonant (like study), the -y is changed to **-ied** \rightarrow **study** \rightarrow **studied**.

 If it ends in a vowel + y (like play), simply -ed is added → play → played.

Subject + Verb in past + Complement

- 2. They ate pizza after school.
- Negative form
