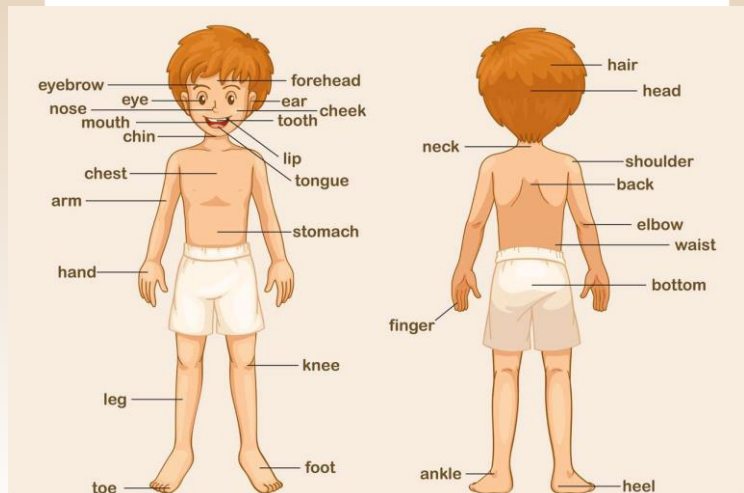

Regular and irregular verbs in past simple

Regular verbs form the simple past tense by adding -ed to the end of the verb.

Regular verbs

Present simple	Past simple
work	worked
play	played
clean	cleaned
watch	watched
cook	cooked

Irregular verbs

Present simple	Past simple
write	wrote
red	read
keep	kept
fall	fell
sing	sang
lose	lost
run	ran
catch	caught
choose	chose
think	though
speak	spoke
be	was/were

Structures

Affirmative form



Subject + verb in past + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. Mariana visited Paris last summer.
2. Laura watched a movie last night.

Negative form



Subject + negation + verb in present + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. Luis didn't eat vegetables.
2. We didn't like loud music.

Interrogative form



Question + subject + verb in present + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. Did Mariana finish her homework?
2. Did Lura and Luis go to the party last night?
