

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Structures

Affirmative form

Subject + verb in past + complement

EXAMPLES:

- 1. Mariana visited Paris last summer.
- 2. Laura watched a movie last night.

Negative form



Subject + negation + verb in present + complement

EXAMPLES:

1. Luis didn't eat vegetables.

2. We didn't like loud music.

Interrogative form



Question + subject + verb in present + complement

EXAMPLES:

- 1. Did Mariana finish her homework?
- 2. Did Lura and Luis go to the party last night?

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
