WEEKDAY: it is from Monday to Friday

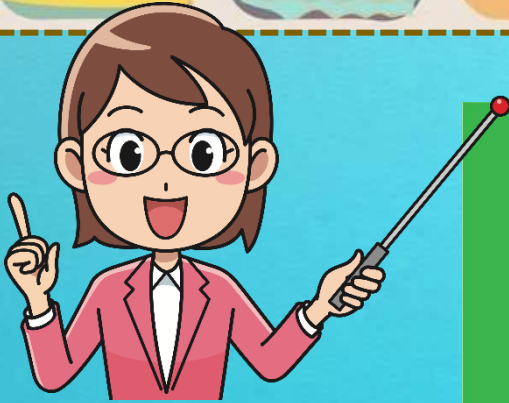
WEEKEND: Is Saturday and Sunday.

Ordinal number; a number defining the position of something in a series, such as 'first', 'second', or 'third'. Ordinal numbers are used as adjectives, nouns, and pronouns.
