Affirmative form

Subject + verb in past + complement.

Examples.

- She danced last night.
- Jack washed all the dishes.



Negative form.

Subject + negation + verb in present + complement.

Examples.

- 1 didn't go to the gym.
- They did not plant trees.



Interrogative form.

Question + subject + verb in present + complement?

Examples.

- Did you have a question?
- Did she need to sleep?
