"Be Going To"

#### **Affirmative Form**

Structure: Subject + am/is/are + going to + base verb

#### **Examples:**

- 1. I am going to study for my exam.
- 2. She is going to travel to Spain.
- 3. They are going to watch a movie tonight.

#### **Negative Form**

#### Structure:

Subject + am/is/are + not + going to + base verb

#### **Examples:**

- 1. I am not going to eat junk food.
- 2. He is not going to play football tomorrow.
- 3. We are not going to visit the museum.

#### **Interrogative Form**

#### Structure:

Am/Is/Are + subject + going to + base verb?

#### **Examples:**

- 1. Are you going to study tonight?
- 2. Is she going to bake a cake?
- 3. Are they going to arrive on time?
