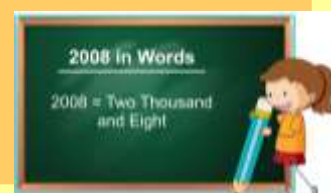
### Seasons

# Ordinal Numbers

1st – first	6th – sixth	11th – eleventh
2nd – second	7th – seventh	12th – twelfth
3rd – third	8th – eighth	13th – thirteenth, etc.
4th – fourth	9th – ninth	
5th – fifth	10th – tenth	

We use them in dates:

- March 3rd = *Third of March*
- July 21st = *Twenty-first of July*

## Future with "Be Going To"

### Affirmative Form

#### Structure:

Subject + am/is/are + going to + base verb

#### Examples:

1. I am going to study for my exam.
2. She is going to travel to Spain.
3. They are going to watch a movie tonight.

### Negative Form

#### Structure:

Subject + am/is/are + not + going to + base verb

#### Examples:

1. I am not going to eat junk food.
2. He is not going to play football tomorrow.
3. We are not going to visit the museum.

### Interrogative Form

#### Structure:

Am/Is/Are + subject + going to + base verb?

#### Examples:

1. Are you going to study tonight?
2. Is she going to bake a cake?
3. Are they going to arrive on time?
