EXAMPLES

AFIRMATIVE

- **IAM GOING TO EAT CHICKEN**
- **YOU ARE GOING TO WALK PARK**
- **HE IS GOING TO RIDE CAR**

NEGATIVE

- **I don't play soccer on Sundays.**
- **She doesn't eat vegetables.**
- **They don't go to the park every day.**

INTERROGATIVE

- **Do you see the moon?**
- **Does she sleep early?**
- **Do they listen to the teacher?**
