REGULAR VERBS

Regular verbs are those that, when conjugated, maintain the same root and follow a conjugation pattern specific to each group (ending in -ar, -er, or -ir).

IRREGULAR VERBS

Irregular verbs are those that, when conjugated, do not follow the regular conjugation patterns of their conjugation.

QUESTIONS

WH- questions are questions that begin with interrogative pronouns whose first letters are "wh" (except "how").

Affirmative:
Subject + verb + ed
Negative:
Subject + did not + base verb

CONCEPT

In a flexible language, a regular verb is a verb that has uniform conjugations.

• What did he find and where did he find it?
• Who did she visit and when did she visit him?

PRESENT:

• What do they work on and what do they do with it?

• work • play • clean
• watch • call • visit
• open • dance • talk
• travel

PAST

• worked • played
• watched • called
• visited • opened
• danced • talked

PRESENT

• go • come • fly
• see • eat • find
• cut • drink • know
• take • write

PAST

• went • came
• saw • ate
• bought • drank
• took • wrote
