Verbo to be (plural)

To be (plural)

We are = Nosotros somos / estamos

You are = Ustedes son / están

They are = Ellos/Ellas son / están

Ejemplos:

We are students.

You are friends.

They are in class.

Usamos There is / There are.

There is = hay (singular)

There are = hay (plural)

There is a notebook in my bag.

There are two pens in my bag.
