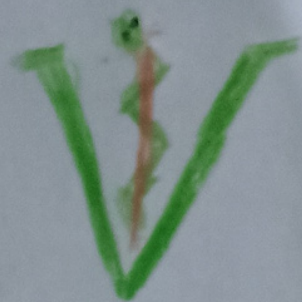

- 2- Knowledge of techniques for establishing accurate diagnoses, establishing effective treatments, and, likewise, establishing the necessary measures to prevent animals diseases that are transmitted to humans
- 3- Have solid scientific and technical knowledge in the various branches of livestock sciences, within a research culture, which will allow them to effectively manage the various viable alternatives for solving sector specific problems
- 4- Certify the condition and quality of various animal products intended for human consumption or benefit, as well as those related to public health
- 5- Actively participate in and lead various activities related to associative forms of production marketing, and sectoral research that allow for dynamic participation, with special emphasis
- 6- Understand and assimilate the current economic reality or for social, economic, productive, and administrative environment to understand the need for renewal and actively participate in interdisciplinary teams that contribute to the proactive solution of the problems and challenges that arise within the society in which they are immersed.

This is a multidimensional concept that incorporates the distribution of wealth and income, prestige and power.

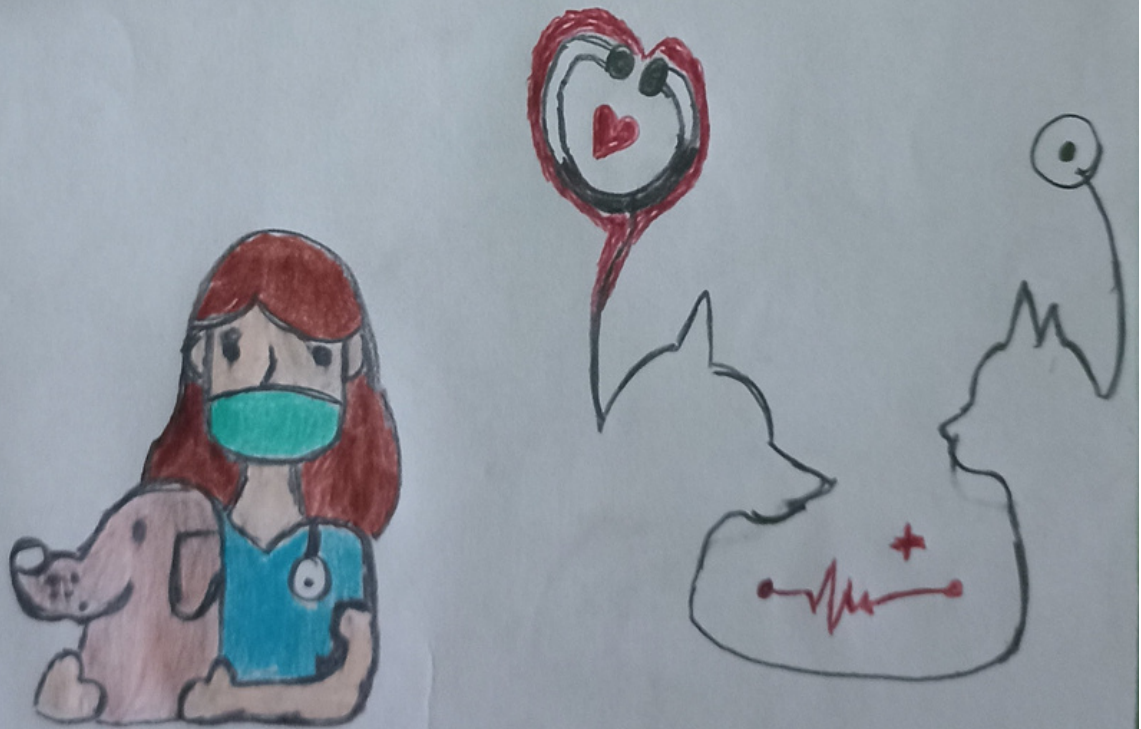
IMPORTANCE OF VETERINARY ZOOTECHNICS IN SOCIETY
