ARTICLE A, AN

USE OF THIS AND THESE / IT AND THEY

PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE

IT MEANS "SER OR
ESTAR" IN SPANISH AND
PLACES, STATES, OR
ACTIONS.

THEY ARE USED THAT
INDICATE OWNERSHIP OR
BELONGING, AND ALWAYS PRO-
BE A NOUN TO SPECIFY WHO
OWNS SOMETHING.

"A" ARE USED IN
CONSONANTS.
"AN" ARE USED IN
VOWELS.

THIS IS USED FOR A SINGLE
OBJECT OR PERSON, AND
THESE FOR SEVERAL PEOPLE
OR OBJECTS.

INDICATE THE LOCATION
OF A PERSON OR OBJECT
IN RELATION TO ANOTHER
ANSWERING THE QUESTION
WHERE IS IT? OR WHERE
IS IT LOCATED?
